Students successfully completing the admissions process after the initial round of evaluations will be offered placement as openings occur.

FIRST THROUGH FIFTH GRADE APPLICANT CHECKLIST

REQUIREMENTS

First grade applicants must be six years old by September 1 of the year they enter school.

RETURN THESE MATERIALS TO THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE

Submit the online Application for Admission, which should include:
□ Official birth certificate
□ \$50.00 application fee.
Applicants applying for first through fifth grade should provide official academic records for the current and previous two school years.
Have a previous teacher complete the First-Fifth Grade Confidential Teacher Evaluation and return to the school.

TESTING

- Independent admissions tests can be administered through the admissions office weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. We also offer Saturday group test dates three times per year.
- Students applying for first grade will only be required to take the OLSAT (Otis-Lennon School Ability Test).
- Students applying for second through fourth grade will take the OLSAT (Otis-Lennon School Ability Test) and the ISEE (Independent School Entrance Exam).
- Students applying for fifth grade will take the ISEE (Independent School Entrance Exam).
- The Admissions Office must receive the application form and fees before testing can be scheduled. Parents should call the Admissions Office at 334-273-2992 to set up the OLSAT and/or to find out how to register for the ISEE. Please note that a testing fee of \$110 is payable to ISEE at the time of registration.
- If a student is moving to Montgomery and is unable to take the ISEE with us, please note that students may take this test at any of the ISEE test sites. Please refer to the ISEE website to locate a convenient test site for you. The Saint James School code is 011904.

NOTIFICATION

 Parents of students completing the application process during the initial round of evaluations will be notified of the admissions committee's decision in March.
