What to know...

- All students/parents must complete all necessary forms & contact information card for 9th period staff use.
- All contact information must include a current cell number
- All authorized pick-up individuals must be listed on the contact card with full name and cell number

What to expect...

- Snacks are provided daily
- Student water bottles are permitted in clear water bottles only

9th Period Billing and Payments

*Options I, II, & III below are billed on your FACTS account.

Registration fee per child: \$75.00 billed on July 1st FACTS account and \$100 after July 1st billed on FACTS account after signed contract is received.

Option I: 4 or more days a week* // 3:11 pm MS/3:19 HS - 5:30 pm // \$160 per month

Option II: 3 days a week or less* // 3:11 pm MS/3:19 HS - 5:30 pm // \$110 per month

Option III: Pre-paid Drop-In Card // 10 Drop-ins 3:11 pm - 5:30 pm // \$125 per card
