SIXTH THROUGH TWELFTH GRADE APPLICANT CHECKLIST

- Submit the online Application for Admission (with Student Response Section), including:
 - Official birth certificate
 - \$75.00 application fee

- Have the appropriate teacher(s) complete and return the required Teacher Evaluation Forms:
 - Middle/High School Mathematics Teacher Evaluation Form
 - Middle/High School English Teacher Evaluation Form

- Applicants applying for **Sixth through Eighth grade** should provide:
 - Official academic records for the current and previous two school years
 - These records should include attendance and the the most recent standardized test

- Applicants applying for **Ninth through Twelfth grade** should provide:
 - Official transcript, including the most recent semester completed
 - These transcripts must show credits earned

- Complete grade level Admissions testing requirements. (Admissions testing varies by grade. It may involve math, reading, and writing at age appropriate levels, employing standardized testing and our own admission assessment tools.)

Parents of students completing the application process during the initial round of evaluations will be notified of the admissions committee's decision.

- *First round Applicants will be notified in March*
- *Applicants after the first round will be notified within one week*

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
